## Team Camp Features

NOTE: Each coach will be hired as an "Independent Contractor" and will be issued a 1099 Misc. Form from Catawba College.

NOTE: Eight players per team is recommended in order to avoid fatigue and to cover any injuries to squad members. For each team, there must be a coach. If you desire to coach more than one of your teams, that is acceptable, or you can split duties with your assistant.

## Housing and Meals

Boarding campers will be housed in the college dormitories with counselor and coaches' supervision. You must provide your own linens (sheets, pillow, pillowcase) for single beds, towels and personal toilet articles, as well as appropriate attire for camp participation, including a swimsuit. Balanced meals will be served in the college cafeteria. Overflow housing is in a local hotel.

## Health Care & Insurance

Qualified sports medicine specialists will be available at all times to treat athletic injuries. Players can receive treatment at all sessions and taping will be available, if tape is supplied. Each participant will be covered by secondary insurance while attending the camp. The insurance provides coverage secondary to the individual's family policy. Individual responsible for amount of deductible.

**NOTE: A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS. BRING THE DOCTOR'S EXAMINATION REPORT ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE CAMP SESSION.**

## Time of Arrival

Campers should arrive on Monday morning, between 9:00 am and 9:30 a.m. Registration and room assignments will be made upon your arrival. All teams will begin play at 10:00am that day. Please be on time! Lunch will be served Monday in the Dining Hall.

**TIME OF DEPARTURE:** The camp will end on Wednesday afternoon, following tournaments.

## Costs

Per player - \$260.00 for boarding camper (A non-refundable deposit of \$25 from each player is due by May 15, 2012. After June 1, a late fee of \$5 per player will be charged.) ### ★ POSITION PLAY CAMP FOR POINTS, WINGS AND POST ★

#### AT CATAWBA COLLEGE JUNE 15-16, 2012

Catawba coaches will conduct the area's only "Position Play Camp for Points, Wings & Post." The camp is designed for post players and guards who seek to learn how to play their positions to the best of their abilities. The camp is for the more advanced player and those wanting to prepare themselves for men's college play. For two days and one night the players will undergo an intense and highly specialized training camp.

The camp will spend the majority of time in teaching and repetition. Players will be divided into small groups for instruction with emphasis on the development of individual skills. The camp will be conducted similar to a college practice.

#### AT MYRTLE BEACH JULY 30-31, 2012

The cost for the CATAWBA camp is \$180.00 (2 per room). This fee includes room and board, insurance, t-shirt, and instruction. A physical examination is required and a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit. Also, the cost of the "Position Play Camp" is only \$150.00 (4 per room) if you attend the "Team Camp".
